Federal SAMHSA Grant to Virginia

- Virginia awarded \$9,762,332 for one year (April 29, 2017- April 28, 2018) to provide opioid prevention, treatment, and recovery services
- Goals:
 - Decrease abuse of prescription drugs and heroin overdoses
 - Increase the number of people who receive treatment for opioid use disorder
 - Increase the number of people participating in recovery services
